The Bavarian capital steeped in history and bursting with energy has so much to offer. But did you know that Munich is perched on the threshold of so much more? **Why not have a day out and discover the real picture book Bavaria?** Two such typical Bavarian towns and also renowned holiday resorts are **Murnau** and **Oberammergau** in the Bavarian Alps.

**Enjoy an unforgettable experience!**

Nestled at the foothills of the Alps are two of Bavaria's most picturesque towns. Discover the artist town of Murnau, home of Kandinsky, Münter and the Blue Rider, and the neighbouring town of Oberammergau, world famous for its Passion Play and its exquisite wood carving tradition.

## Step 1 Murnau

**By car:** A 40 minute drive, Murnau is located South of Munich, simple route straight ahead on the highway A95, all the way to the exit Murnau that is signposted.

**By train:** Go to Munich central station, purchase either a “Bayern-Ticket Single” (19 €) or a “Bayern-Ticket” (27 €, valid for 5 persons). Direct line all the way to Murnau, train leaves Munich at 8.32 am from platforms 27 – 36. Arrival in Murnau at 9.29 am. <sup>1</sup>



### Program in Murnau (4 hours):

Sample the 3 traditional types of beer and savour delicious Bavarian specialities at the local brewery restaurant Griesbräu, shop at leisure in one of the most historical and beautifully preserved pedestrian zones in Upper Bavaria, take in the expressionist artwork in the Castle Museum and at the “Münter House” museum where once upon a time Wassily Kandinsky lived and painted. In summer, take a stroll down to the exquisite Lake Staffelsee where rental boats are available or alternatively take a dip in the soft and clear water. Take the opportunity to walk through the Murnau Moor nature reserve, a paradise for all nature fans. In winter, enjoy spiced wine and festive spirit at the Christmas market or take a ride on a one-horse open sleigh.

<sup>1</sup> Note for both ticket types: Valid Mo – Fri from 9 am on, Sat + Sun all day, unlimited journeys in all regional trains in second class, if you plan your trip on a weekday a supplementary fee applies, please enquire at the ticket counter of German Rail.



## Step 2 Oberammergau

**By car:** Follow the signs to Bad Kohlgrub and from there on towards Oberammergau (27 km, 30 minutes).

**By train:** Relax and take in one of the most beautiful scenic train journeys that nature has to offer. From Murnau, take the train direct to Oberammergau, departs at 1.20 pm (1.42 pm Sat + Sun) from platform 1a. Arrival in Oberammergau at 1.57 pm (2.20 pm Sat + Sun).



### Program in Oberammergau (4 hours):

Visit the world-famous Passion Play Theatre, the Oberammergau Museum and the Pilatus House where you are given the opportunity to observe a variety of artists at work. Meander through the village avenues and alley ways and view the delightfully painted facades. Discover the secrets of the fascinating wood carving tradition. If you want an in-depth and compact visual experience, pre-book the guided tour "My Passion" with Helga Stuckenberger who was cast as Maria at the last Passion Play in 2000 at +49 (0) 88 22 - 92 27 40. So much to see and so much to do, so why not take advantage and extend your stay in the Ammergau Alps: Join the excursions to the nearby monastery of Ettal and admire the 18th century architecture. Another Bavarian highlight not to be missed is the Linderhof Palace, one of the homes of fairy tale king Ludwig II.





## Step 3 Return to Munich

**By car:** Follow the signs back to Bad Kohlgrub and Murnau. Then to highway A95, follow the highway which leads you straight into Munich.

**By train:** Take the train from Oberammergau direct to Murnau, departing at 6.40 pm, arriving in Murnau at platform 1a at 7.20 pm. In Murnau, go to platform 1 where the train to Munich leaves at 7.29 pm arriving at Munich central station at 8.27 pm.



Arriving back in Munich in the bustling Bavarian capital, your day trip has come to an end, but the memories and impressions of the Bavarian Alps and the real picture book Bavaria will remain forever.
